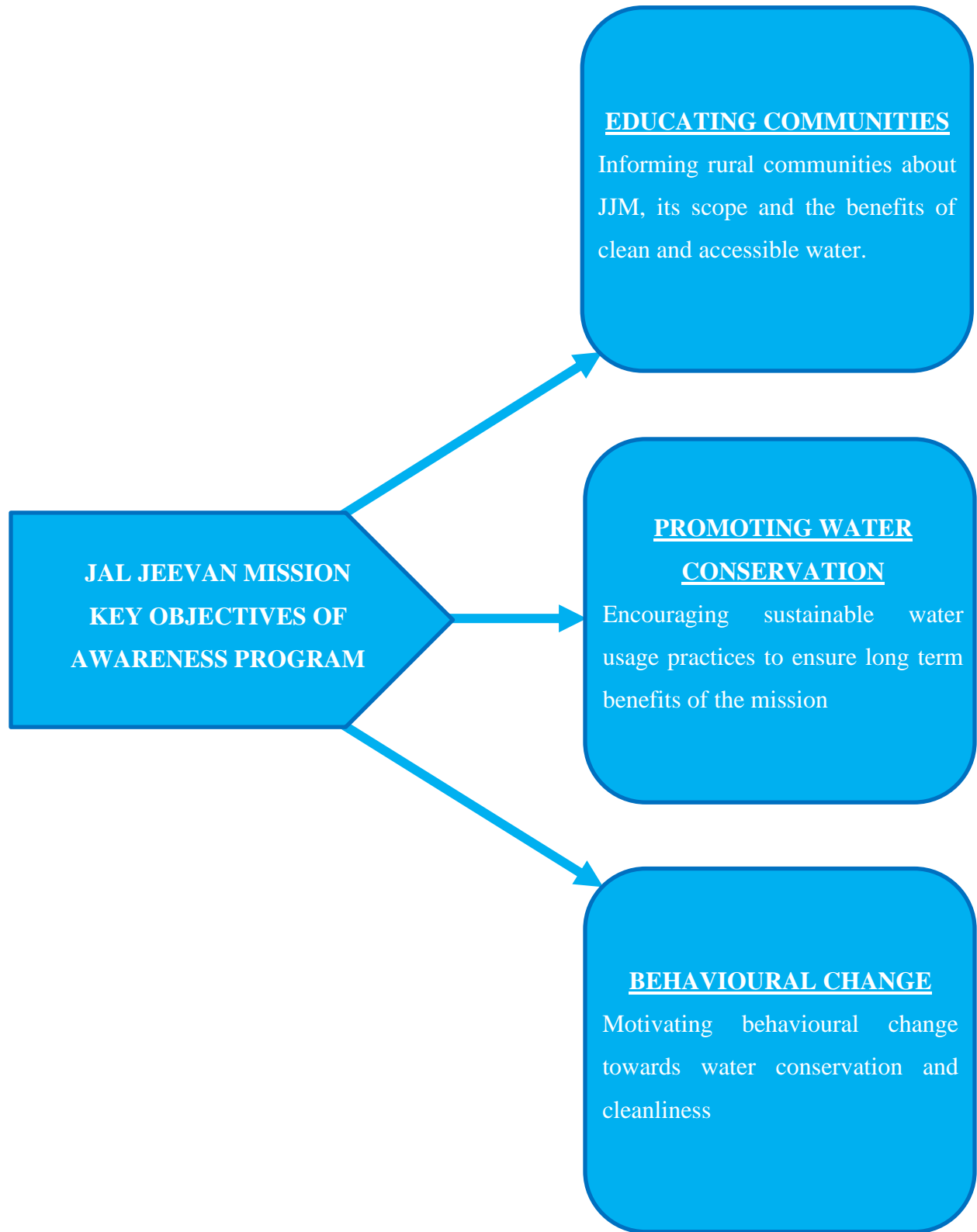
PROGRAM REVIEW

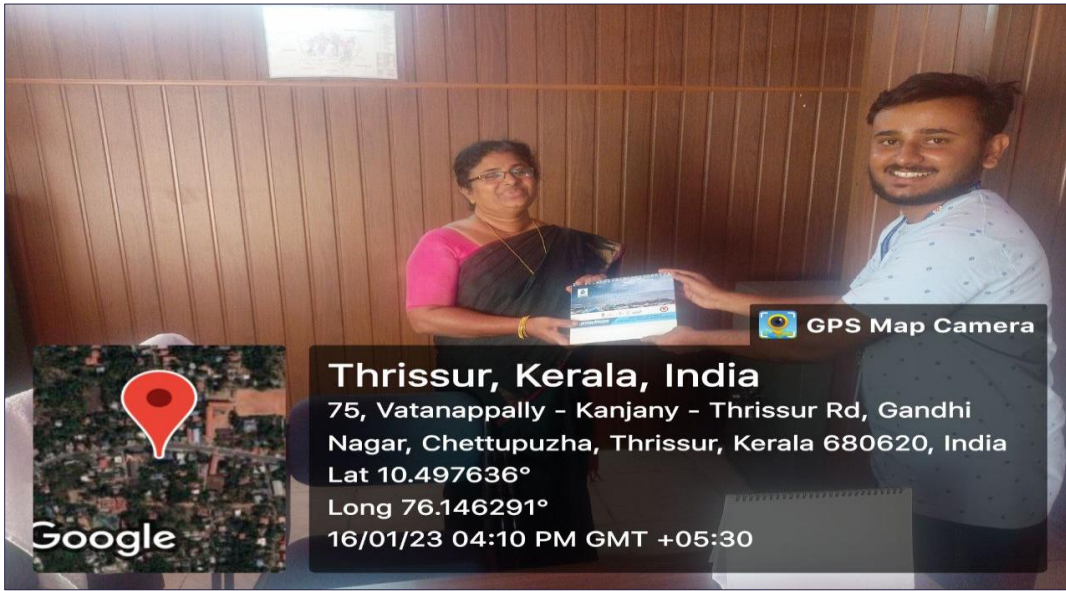

JAL JEEVAN MISSION - ASSISTING NODAL AGENCY:

ISA stands for collecting information based on the complaints of Gram Panchayat administrators, Panchayat officials, general public, consumers etc., understanding the complaints and resolving them without delay.

- 7, Collection of list of those requiring connection by ward members
- 8, Providing proper assistance to Panchayat and Water Authority to resolve their doubts
10. To identify the beneficiaries who do not have access to Consumer ID and provide assistance for obtaining Consumer ID.
- 11, Attending Gram Sabhas in connection with Jal Jeevan Mission
- 12, settlement of public doubts

13. Prompt problem resolution through the assistance of contractors and coordinators.

14, Attending meetings related to Panchayat and Water Authority

15, Current Connection List a. Delivery to ward members with the help of Es 16, Convening meeting with Water Authority as per requirement of Panchayat

In the case of non-availability of water, all the bills were collected and handed over to the water authority as per the approval of the Panchayat Committee. Steps have been taken to stop the water bill temporarily. Grievances from the general public are properly reported to the groups by the respective ward members and the same is brought to the attention of the concerned officials as soon as possible and coordinated action is taken to redress the same at the earliest. All these activities are done with the help of Water Authority officials, Panchayat administrators and officials for the Implementation Support Agency to carry out proper interventions.

RAINWATER HARVESTING SYSTEM

Rain water harvesting is a technique used to gather and store rain water that runs off natural or man made catchment area such as roof tops, compounds, hill slopes, rocky surfaces, or artificially repaired impervious or semi - pervious surfaces. The process is carried out using artificially designated systems. The water collected through rain water harvesting can be filtered, stored and used for various purposes. EDS implemented rain water harvesting system in different panchayaths.

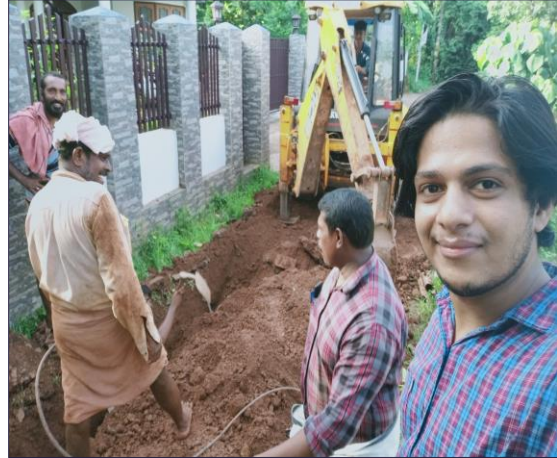

In the case of non-availability of water, all the bills were collected and handed over to the water authority as per the approval of the Panchayat Committee. Steps have been taken to stop the water bill temporarily. Grievances from the general public are properly reported to the groups by the respective ward members and the same is brought to the attention of the concerned officials as

soon as possible and coordinated action is taken to redress the same at the earliest. All these activities are done with the help of Water Authority officials, Panchayat administrators and officials for the Implementation Support Agency to carry out proper interventions.



URJA KIRAN 2023-2024

URJA KIRAN can be referred as energy management campaign. The objective of **URJA KIRAN** is to create awareness among the general public and equip them for efficient management of all forms of energy, to promote energy efficiency and energy conservation and to develop new sources of energy as well as novel energy technologies with a view to increasing the production and facilitating the use of energy on a sustainable basis. It aims at seeking the Participating Agencies (PAs) to convene, catalyze and facilitate works in the energy conservation related activities in a participatory mode across the State.
